*It all began in the year before the Battle of Trafalgar whilst England was fighting the Napoleonic Wars. At that time Ramsgate was the port from which troops & stores sailed to the Continent. The Duke of Wellington stayed with his Headquarters staff at the London Hotel in Ramsgate, which was owned by Robert Page & his younger brother Richard. At that time, there was a threat of invasion by Napoleon & among those caught up in the invasion scare was a grocer named Fisher. He offered his shop on the corner of Harbour Street & Market Place for sale & hastily left the town. The Iron Duke had taken a liking to young Richard, then just 24, & advised him to buy the empty grocer's shop. Richard took his advice & invested his life savings in the new venture in 1804, establishing a business which has been passed on from father to son for seven generations.*

- Bushmills Black Bush, 40%** £ 3.60  
*This Irish Whiskey combines malt whiskey with a lighter grain whiskey which is then matured in former Oloroso Sherry and Bourbon casks. This unique recipe means black bush has rich, fruity notes and a deep intense character, balanced by an incredibly unique smoothness.*
- Dalwhinnie, 15 yrs, 43%** £ 4.00  
*A great malt which Jim Murray awarded 95 points in his Whisky Bible, this is excellent value for money. The flavours are simple, but flawless, a clean, crisp 15-year-old from the Dalwhinnie distillery, also part of Diageo's Classic Malts range.*
- English Whisky Classic, 43%** £ 4.50  
*An unpeated single malt from the English Whisky Company, produced at the St. George's Distillery in Norfolk - a fine place to start if you're interested in exploring English whisky.*
- English Chapter 11, 46%** £ 4.60  
*The first ever heavily peated whisky from the English Whisky Company, distilled by the St. George's Distillery in Norfolk. Good body, with very smoky malt, as well as Latakia pipe tobacco, peat, vanilla and ginger and aniseed. Big and powerful, some chili heats late palate.*
- Glenfiddich Malt Master's, 43%** £ 6.40  
*The Glenfiddich Malt Master's Edition was named for the distillery's sixth Malt Master, Brian Kinsman, as he was their first Malt Master to double-mature Glenfiddich whisky in two different casks. This expression was initially matured in traditional oak casks, but was then finished for a number of years in Sherry casks to further develop the flavours, bringing warming fruitcake and gingerbread notes to the table.*
- Glenmorangie 10-Year-Old, 40%** £ 4.40  
*The Original is the flagship single malt Scotch whisky from the Glenmorangie Distillery in the Highlands. Matured in a combination of first-and-second-fill American white oak casks for 10 years, the expression is a benchmark for creamy, approachable single malt. A long-running go-to dram for many whisky enthusiasts (including a few here at MoM Towers), this stuff is superb as an aperitif, though more than suitable for enjoying on a cooler evening.*
- Highland Park, Viking Honour, 40%** £ 4.00  
*The heart and soul of Highland Park, VIKING HONOUR is a perfect harmony of aromatic smoky peat, sweet heather honey and rich fruit cake.*
- Johnnie Walker Black, 40%** £ 3.60  
*A much-loved and respected 12-year-old blended Scotch, Johnnie Walker Black Label is one of the world's most famous blends. Born in 1909, Black Label is a blend of around 40 whiskies(!), with a distinctive mellow smoky note.*

<i>Monkey Shoulder Scotch is a superb blended malt whisky from William Grant, made with single malts from three famous Speyside distilleries. The result is a smooth, creamy, supple and very malty Scotch which works superbly well neat, over ice, or in whisky cocktails (where it really excels).</i>	
<b>Nikka From The Barrel, 51%</b>	£ 6.00
<i>The award-winning Nikka Whisky From The Barrel blend is absolutely full of flavour. Bottled at 51.4% ABV. The blend combines both single malt and grain whiskies from the Miyagikyo and Yoichi distilleries, which are then married in a huge variety of casks, including bourbon barrels, sherry butts and refill hogsheads. A huge depth of flavour in this stunning Japanese whisky. We can't recommend this enough.</i>	
<b>Powers John's Lane 12yrs, 46%</b>	£ 5.40
<i>A single pot still release of Powers whisky. It's matured in a combination of bourbon and oloroso sherry casks, and named after the distillery where it was first made, now sadly closed.</i>	
<b>Smokehead, 43%</b>	£ 3.80
<i>Smokehead is a superb, cult single malt from Ian MacLeod. Just a massive, thick peat smoke rich dram. Plenty of great south Islay character.</i>	
<b>Talisker, 45.8%</b>	£ 4.20
<i>A classic Island dram from the Isle of Skye. Aged for a minimum of 10 years in American oak casks, this welcome member of Diageo's Classic Malts series has been recognised numerous times for its excellence.</i>	
<b>The MacPhail's Collection, 43%</b>	£ 5.10
<i>Bottled by Gordon and MacPhail at 8 years of age, this single malt is matured in Sherry butts and bourbon barrels. This is a pleasant, creamy, slightly smoky dram with ample character.</i>	
<b>Yamazaki, 43%</b>	£ 7.30
